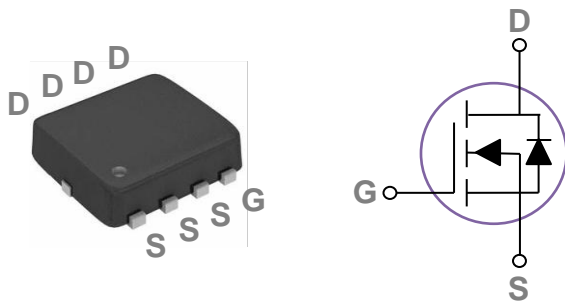

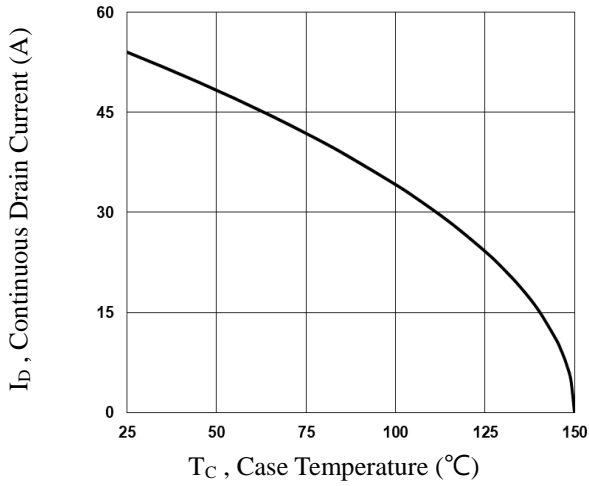


Fig.1 Continuous Drain Current vs. T_c

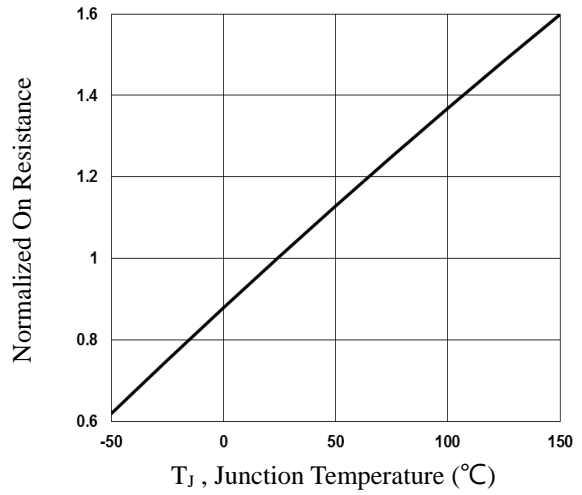


Fig.2 Normalized R_{DS(on)} vs. T_j

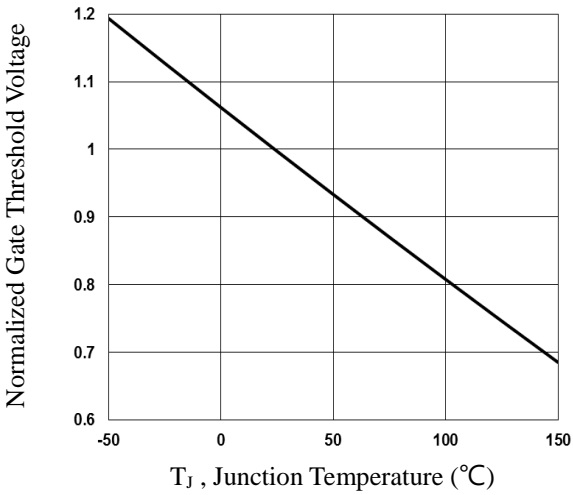


Fig.3 Normalized V_{th} vs. T_j

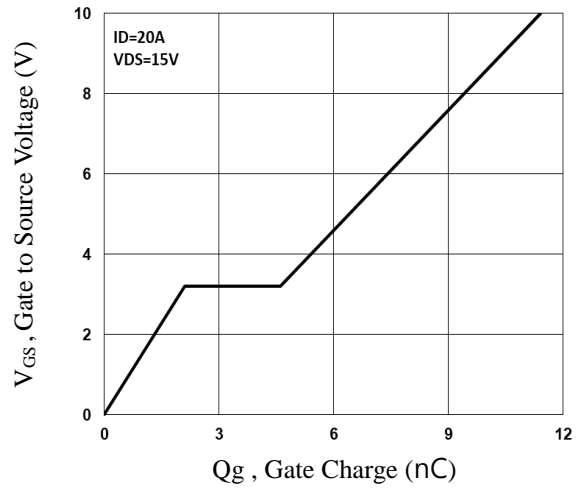


Fig.4 Gate Charge Waveform

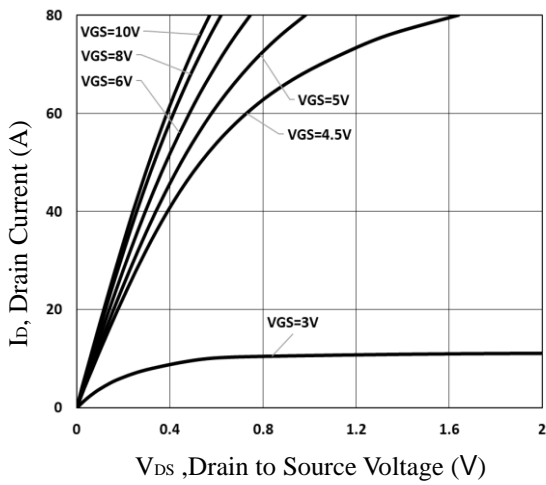


Fig.5 Typical Output Characteristics

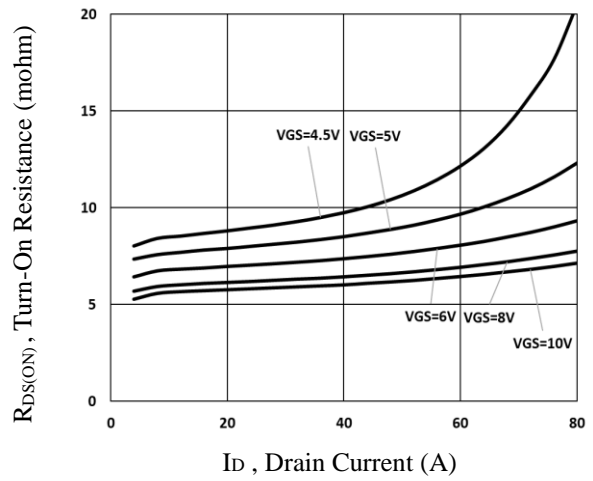


Fig.6 Turn-On Resistance vs. I_D

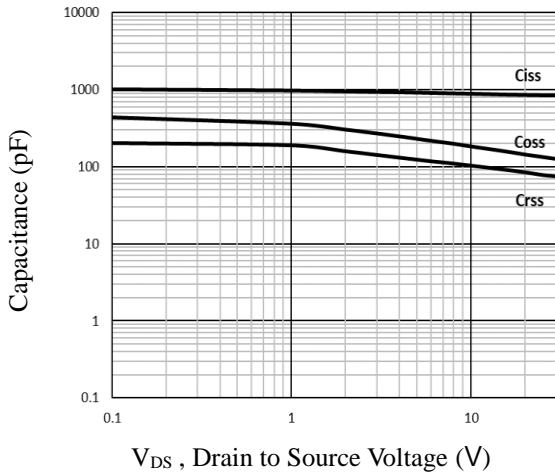


Fig.7 Capacitance Characteristics

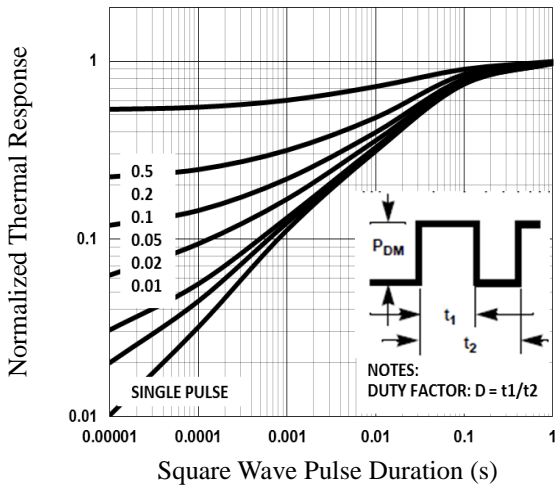


Fig.8 Normalized Transient Impedance

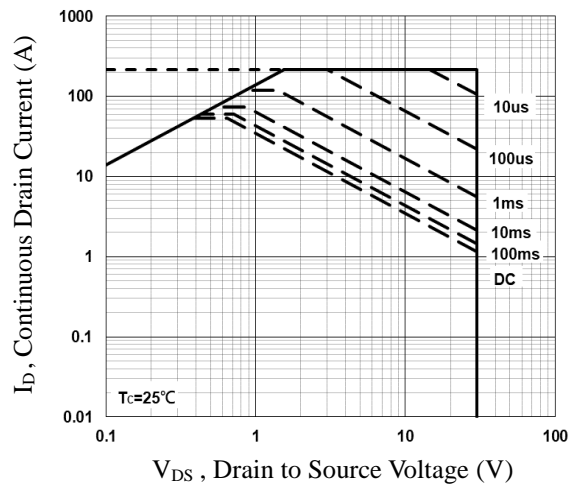


Fig.9 Maximum Safe Operation Area

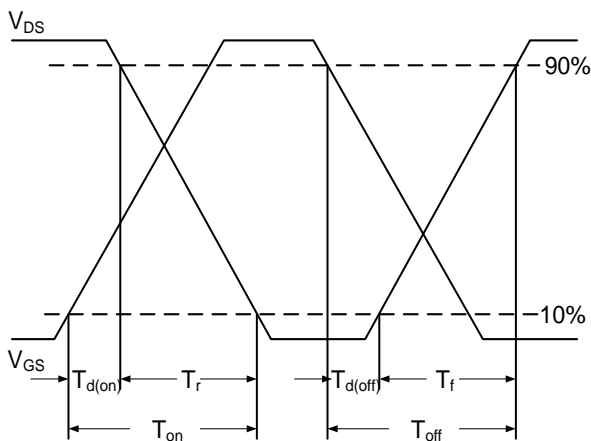


Fig.10 Switching Time Waveform

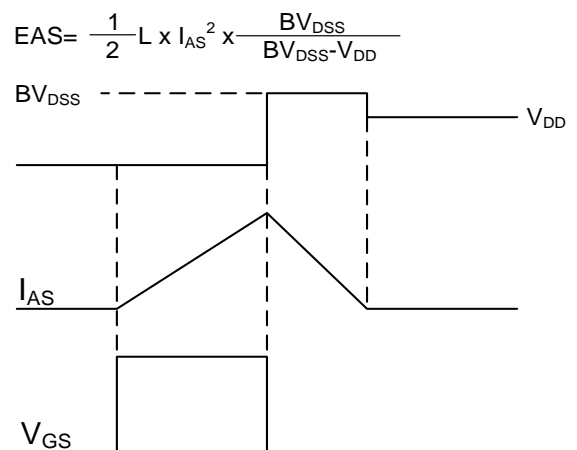
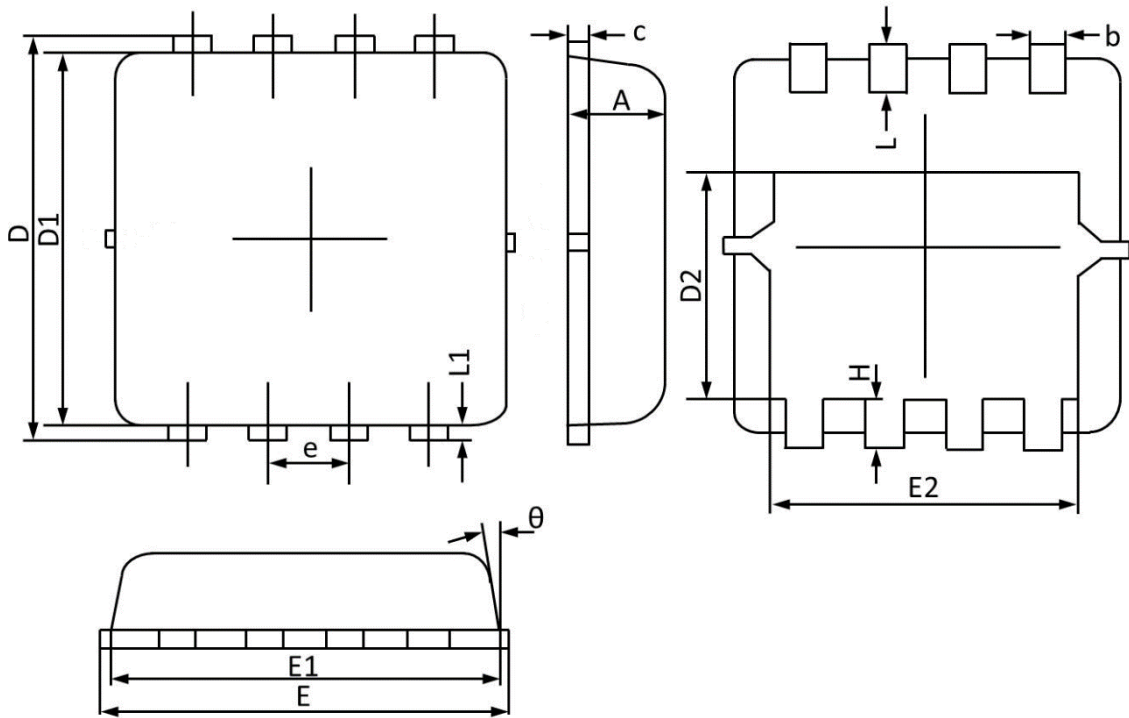


Fig.11 EAS Waveform
